Instructions:

1. To graduate you must complete 6 heats safely. DNS, DNF, and DQ's do not count towards graduation.
2. You must volunteer for either air fence setup **or** teardown, complete a ½ day of working with the race day staff, **and** corner work one complete race day in order to graduate per Section B, section 14.c.II of the rulebook.
3. On the day you expect to complete the last of your six heats, fill out this form and submit it to the race director.
4. Notify your mentoring instructor(s).
5. **Graduated novices** must race in the appropriate expert classes that their bike qualifies for.
6. **Graduated novices** will be issued an 800 number for the remainder of their novice season. As a graduated novice, you are required to run yellow number plates and wear a large "X" on the back of leathers or helmet, color to contrast with protective gear.
