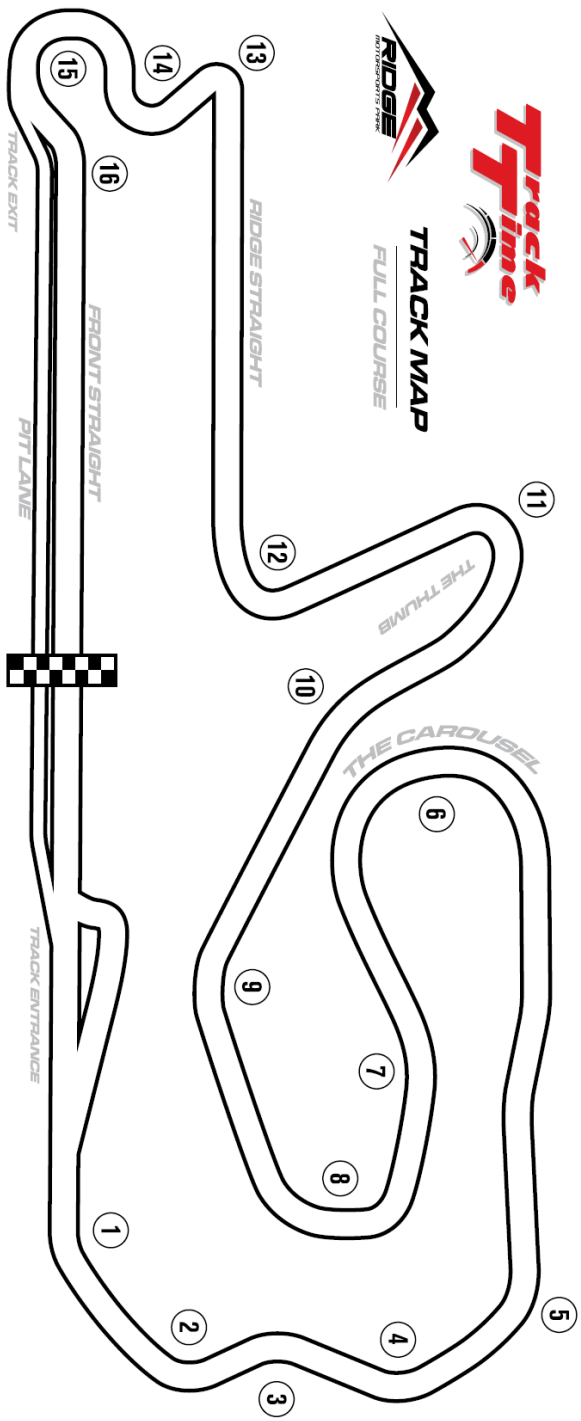
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Track Map

When did you start racing and how did you get into it? What bike(s) do you ride/classes do you race in?

2025 was my first race season on my 2008 Yamaha R6. I started in 600 Novice / Amateur. As soon as I got into track days, I knew racing was something I eventually wanted to do. In 2022, I attended Taste of Racing and watched WMRRA do its thing for the first time, and that really solidified my desire to get started.

What have been your greatest accomplishments in racing?

My greatest accomplishment was gridding up and racing for the first time. I'm proud of the results and taking home the Amateur championship win, but I'm even more proud of the progress. Getting more comfortable on the bike, learning racecraft, managing nerves, and improving each round has meant a lot to me.

What do you tend to work on the most or what do you struggle with?

Being 6'4", body position and moving around the bike have been the biggest struggles for me. Getting my legs to anchor in, staying loose on the bars, and using my lower body properly have been a big focus.

What advice did you receive when you first started that you found to be the most helpful?

Be smooth and predictable before worrying about being fast. When you're new, it's easy to want to chase lap times or get elbow down for the gram, but smooth inputs, good lines, and being predictable around other riders should be the main focus.

Racer Profile (Cont.)

What would you tell someone who wants to race or is just getting started?

I would tell them to just start. There's a misconception that you need to be super fast to do track days or race, and that isn't true. Sign up for a track day, get some instruction, check out NRS, ask questions, listen to the experienced riders, and don't let the nerves talk you out of it. The WMRRA paddock is a really supportive place to learn.

What does WMRRA mean to you?

WMRRA has given me a place to challenge myself and be around people who genuinely care about the sport. The people you compete with on track become your family in the paddock. If you toss your bike down, your direct competitor could be in your pit helping you get it back together. It's a community, a goal to work toward, and a place to keep pushing myself to get better.
