### 1. Welcome and Overview

- Kumpy Kump welcomed attendees and outlined the agenda, emphasizing a concise meeting to cover key topics.
- Cherie was introduced as an expert on timing and scoring, invited to assist with related discussions. It was noted that Britini Hobbs is in charge of Timing and Scoring.

### 2. 2026 WMRRA and OMRRA Race Dates

- Kumpy Kump announced that the 2026 WMRRA and OMRRA race dates are finalized, with contracts signed specifically for The Ridge.
- Key changes:
  - The April round will be the weekend after Easter to avoid the holiday.
  - Pacific rounds reduced from two to one (August round replaced with a Ridge round) due to financial losses (~\$13,000 in August and similar loss in September).
- Tico Sandoval shared a mock-up calendar, noting six joint rounds (May 1-3, June 5-7, June 19-21, July 31-Aug 2, August 28-30, September 11-13) and two non-joint rounds (April 17-19, July 17-19).

## 3. Scoring and Points Issues

- Danielle Mulkins-Franklin reported waiting for responses from four novices to finalize the novice list and has reached out to Britny for Ninja 250 scoring review.
- Kumpy Kump noted email issues affecting communication, particularly regarding points problems from Brian Burchill. Chris Wilcox will be contacted to resolve email issues.
- Action Item: Danielle to follow up on novice responses and scoring review. Kumpy to coordinate with Chris Wilcox on email issues.

# 4. Ryan Champ Incident

- Louis Stevenson presented the incident involving Ryan Champ at the last Pacific round:
  - Ryan, an OMRRA rider, reacted aggressively to a race incident involving another rider.
  - Video evidence was shared, showing Ryan's aggressive behavior.
- Proposed Penalty: Louis suggested a one-year ban from all WMRRA events (racing, spectating, track days, banquet). An appeal option was noted.
- Discussion:
  - Some board members advocated for a two-year ban, citing precedent for less severe ontrack incidents, but noted the appeal process could adjust the penalty.
  - Others argued a two-year ban might deter Ryan from returning, suggesting one year is sufficient for punishment and reflection.
  - Discussed concerns about OMRRA's lighter penalty (three-round ban and fine), suggesting better alignment for joint rounds.

- Resolution: Consensus reached for a one-year WMRRA ban, with Ryan able to appeal. Louis to send a formal letter outlining the violation and penalty, with Kumpy to review.
- Action Item: Louis to finalize and send the penalty letter.

## 5. Banquet Planning

- Tico Sandoval updated on the November 8, 2025, banquet:
  - Logistics (venue, catering, beverages, permits) are 90% complete, \$3,000 under last year's budget.
  - 14 people registered; reminders to be sent by week's end.
  - Custom trophies feature a Washington state acrylic design with WMMRA and sponsor logos.
  - Volunteers needed for setup/takedown; venue available from 12 PM to midnight.
  - Mark to MC, Delaney to provide PA and music, lighting and decor completed.

- Discussion:
  - Craig requested clarity on free banquet admittance for corner workers. Tico suggested a registration code for repeat volunteers, with Danielle to provide.
- Action Item: Danielle to provide novice-to-expert list for the program and send registration codes to Craig for corner workers. Tico to finalize sponsorship prospectus by January 1, 2026, and reach out to current/new sponsors.

## 6. Injured Rider Fund

- Don Williams reviewed the Injured Rider and Safety Fund (IRSF) Standard Operating Procedure (SOP, June 2024):
  - Funds support WMRRA racers injured during WMRRA events.
  - Payment tiers: \$200-\$300 (minor injuries, e.g., concussions), \$300-\$500 (broken bones), \$500-\$1,000 (significant injuries), up to \$2,000 (permanent disablement/death).
  - Requests typically come through Don, with board votes required for amounts over \$500.

- Funding sources: 5% of January cash on hand, race registration contributions, Taste of Racing, and external donations.
- Excess funds over \$5,000 roll into next year or safety-related expenses (e.g., air fence, fire extinguishers).
- Injured Riders:
  - Adrielle (Pacific round): Don was unaware but will follow up.
  - Adam Faussett (Pacific round): Don proposed a \$1,000 payment due to significant injuries.
- Resolution: Motion for \$1,000 to Adam passed (Damon seconded, no nays).
- Action Item: Don to email Neil (CC Kumpy) to release \$1,000 to Adam and follow up on Adrielle's injury status.

### 7. Other Business

- Adam Faussett Update: Kumpy reported Adam is in good spirits, in a wheelchair, aiming to return next year..
- Novice Program (Damon Poor):
  - Planning a comprehensive pre-season Novice Racing School (NRS) with classroom and on-track components, mentors assigned, and a mid-season session.
  - Collaborating with OMRRA's novice rep (Turin Cox) for reciprocal NRS recognition.
  - Developing promotional materials (e.g., 4x6 flyers, sandwich boards) for track days, to be finalized with Tico.
- Action Item: Damon to connect with Ben Ngai(Canadian contact) via Paul McComsey for
  potential collaboration. Tico to confirm novice championship awards (open, 600, lightweight) for
  the banquet.
