Are you ready? Is your bike? Is your Trailer? (If you're like me, you may be scrambling to get things buttoned up, but alas, time waits for no one). Our FIRST round is coming up very soon. Registration is OPEN—Round 1 is worth *DOUBLE POINTS!!*

THIS YEAR WE HAVE A FEW CHANGES THAT YOU SHOULD BE AWARE OF:

- 1) **Rotating Weekend's Race Schedule-** Unlike previous years, where the weekend's schedule remains the same for all race rounds and is set for the season, this year it will be rotating—meaning that each race round the weekend's schedule will be adjusted—ultimately, rotating the race classes' start times. For example, if you are in Race 1 for this round, then the next round (In June) you may be in Race 5, and the next round after that, perhaps Race 10, etc. This helps provide fairness and equity for all classes that traditionally have been the first race or the last race of the day.

****CHECK THE SCHEDULE EACH ROUND TO ENSURE YOU KNOW WHEN YOU'RE RACING! ****

- 2) **Roving Tech:** Yes that's right. For \$20 you can get tech to your pits! (You can sign up when you register for your races) If you purchase this, a bright colored sheet of paper will be added to your registration packet.

For racers who have paid for roving tech, please put your fire extinguisher in the throughway in front of your pit to let them know you're ready. You must have a fire extinguisher and a visible pit board with your name and race number, or you will be skipped. Have your bike's belly pan removed (vintage excepted) and all of your gear ready for inspection. Failure may warrant a mobile revisit if time allows and at the discretion of the inspector, but plan on re-teching at the tech tent in the event of a failure.

3) **Two Overall Championships**- We have two distinct Overall Championships for this season. The WMRRA TITLE CHAMPIONSHIP and the WMRRA CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP.

- The *WMRRA Title Championship* is made up of Formula Ultra, Open Superbike, and Open SuperSport
- The *WMRRA Club Championship* is made up of the following classes:
